ROAD GRITTING POLICY

Introduction

Over the winter months when temperatures drop to freezing levels our road gritting policy will be implemented, to help with access into and out of the Park.

Gritting Bin Location

Across the Park we have placed gritting bins in locations where the roads have significant slopes. The contents of these bins are for use on the roads to assist the movement of traffic and not for personal use of driveways or pavements.

Pre Road Gritting

In preparation for winter or bad weather conditions the Warfield Team will:

- Ensure they are aware of the long-term weather forecasts and monitor any severe forecast from the Met Office web site on www.metoffice.gov.uk/weather
- Before bad weather approaches to ensure we have rock salt in stock
- To ensure that in bad weather conditions roads are regularly monitored outside of normal working hours
- All gritting bins have an adequate amount of grit in them

Road Gritting

Road Gritting will take place in the following main areas:

- On the Main Drive between the Tesco entrance of Westmorland Drive
- The Chavey Down Entrance on Longhill Road
- The Main Drive between Harvest Ride and 20 Wellingtonias.
- And additional roads as detailed in red on map at Appendix A (this map is also available in the Park notice board)

Gritting bins can be used by Residents in the areas provided.

Walkway Gritting will take place at:

- MacLaren House
- The Community Hall
- The Tractor Shed

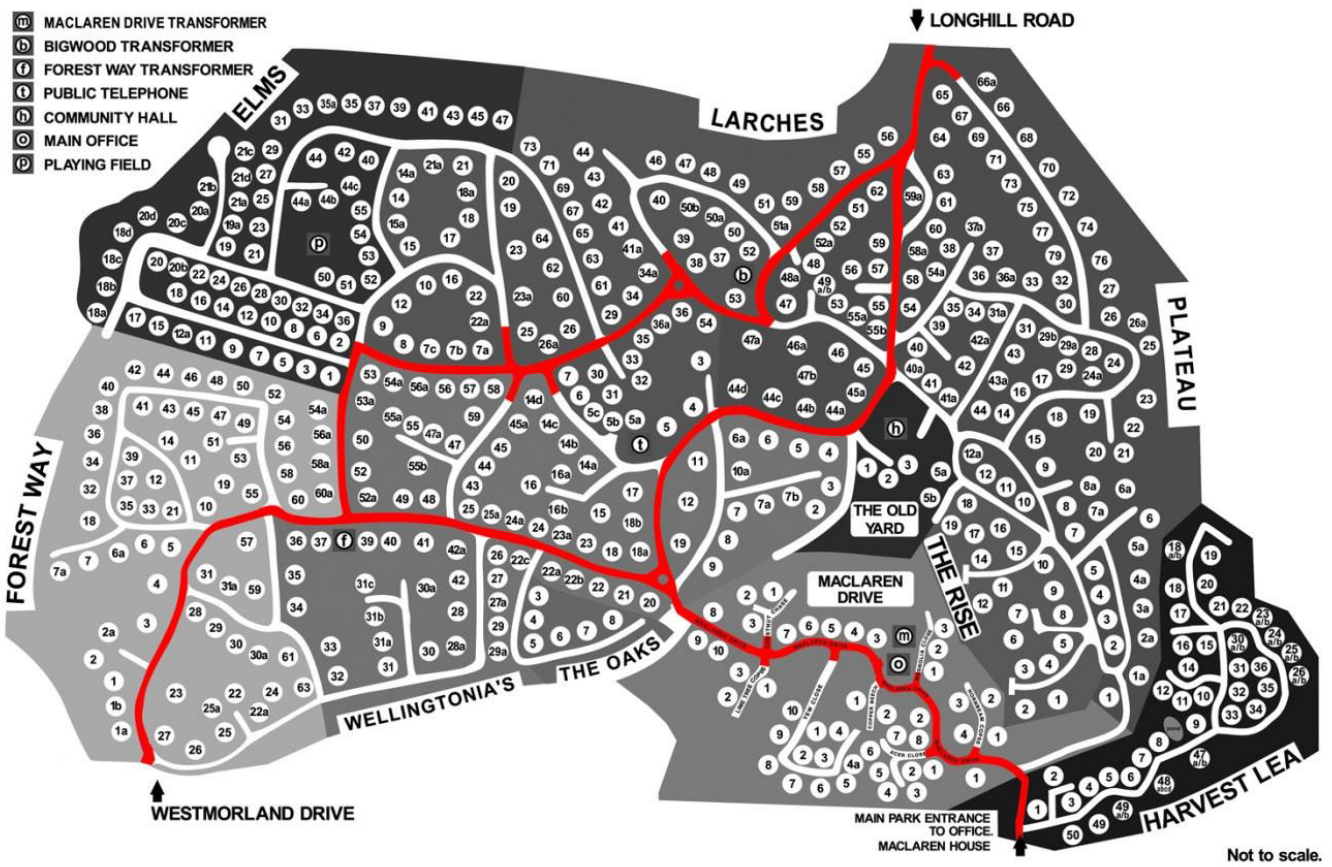
If practical, snow will be cleared as soon as possible in the gritting areas before gritting takes place.
